- § 3000. Official language. English is the official language of Guam, and all persons employed by the government of Guam shall speak only English during working hours. Other languages must not be spoken except for official interpreting. [Included in Original Government Code of Guam enacted by P.L. 1-88, 1952.]
- § 3001. Prohibition: misuse of working time. During office hours all government employees shall devote their time to strictly government business. No clerical, stenographic, or typing work of a private nature shall be performed by any employee for any private party during office hours, and if work is performed outside office hours no government typewriter or stationery shall be used for such work. [Included in Original Government Code of Guam enacted by P.L. 1-88, 1952.]
- § 3002. Same: use of government property. No person is allowed in any of the government offices during office hours except on official business, nor shall any person not an employee be allowed to use government typewriters or stationery at any time. [Included in Original Government Code of Guam enacted by P.L. 1-88, 1952.]
