Dear Speaker Forbes:

Hafa Adai. In reference to FY 2006 Budget Act (P.L. 28-68), enclosed herewith are the demographic profile of MIP clients as required by Subsection 2907.5(2) of the aforementioned law. As transmitted earlier, we provided a comparison of the benefits and services available from the different Government of Guam health insurance plan with the benefits and services of the MIP Program, Subsection 2907.5(3). We do not have the resources or the staff to determine the most generous current Government of Guam health insurance plan. The analysis of benefits and premium payments requires the expertise of an Actuary, which was concurred by the Department of Administration Human Resources Manager.

A communication was made by our department with Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) Comptroller regarding Subsection 2907.5(4) of the law. Likewise, he concurred that analysis of the financial impact on the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority if the MIP benefits are made commensurate with those extended by the health insurance plan requires the expertise of an Actuary.

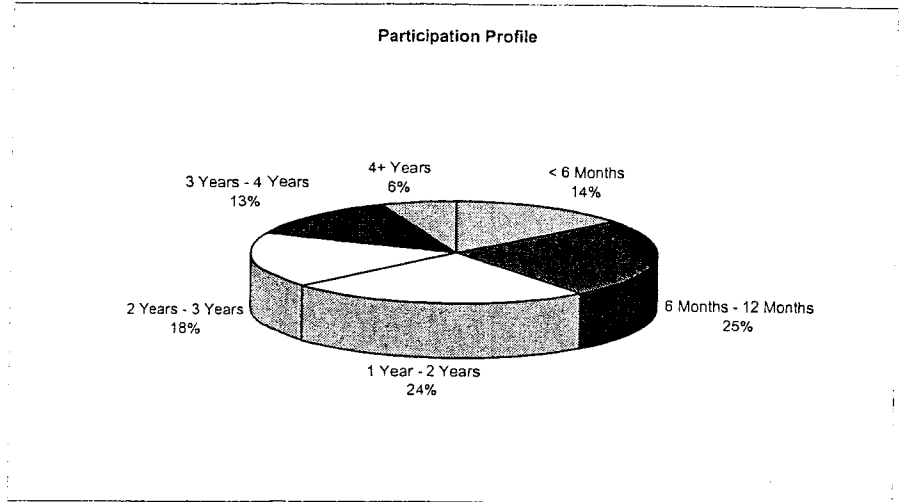

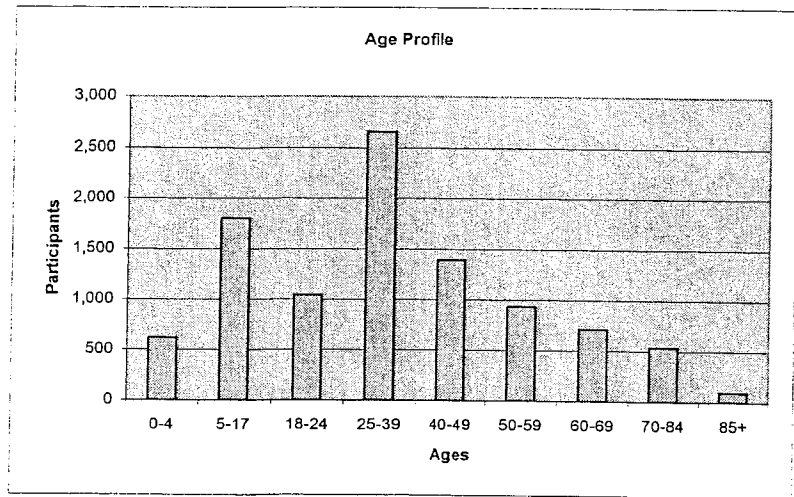

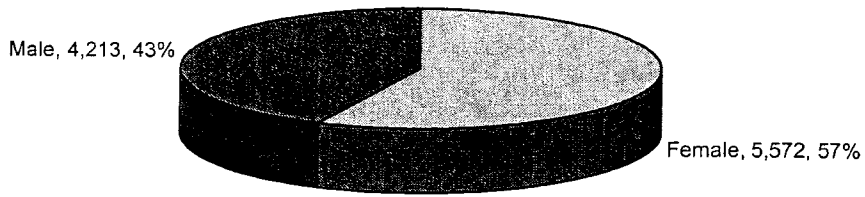
